

PRIVACY POLICY AND CONSENT

Global Funding Partners Pty Ltd ACN 602 324 658 trading as ASSOB Australia (and other related entities) (ASSOB) respects the privacy of personal information that it collects and is committed to managing that information in a responsible manner.

"Personal information" is information we hold which is identifiable as being about you. ASSOB ultimately wants to make your online experience with us satisfying and safe and our aim is to safeguard your privacy and the security of your personal information whilst providing a personalised service that meets your individual needs and preferences. We take this stance not just to fulfill our legislative obligations under the Act, but also because we value your trust and our ongoing relationship.

ASSOB, like other companies operating in Australia, is bound by the 13 Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) as set out in Schedule 1 of the Privacy Amendment (Enhancing Privacy Protection) Act 2012, which amends the Privacy Act 1988 which governs the way we collect, use, disclose, secure and otherwise manage your personal information. Protecting personal information provided to us is important. We will take all reasonable steps to ensure, to the fullest extent possible, that our agents and service providers (third party) are aware of our and their respective obligations under this Privacy Policy. Please note that if you disclose personal information to third parties directly, our policy will not apply, and you will be subject to the privacy policy of that third party.

YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Types of personal information collected

From time to time, it may be necessary for us to collect personal information about you when it is reasonably necessary for a business purpose. The basic personal information we may collect from you is information that can identify you, such as:

- your name, address and contact details
- user ID's and passwords relevant to our website www.assob.com.au
- information about the services provided to you by us, our agents and service providers
- commercial in confidence information
- records of communications or enquiries with ASSOB
- other information relevant to providing you with the services you are seeking

More specific personal information we may collect from you, includes the following:

- copies of identification such as passport, driver licence, utilities notice, deeds, etc for antimoney
- laundering/counter terrorism act (AML/CTF) identification requirements
- bankruptcy details
- bank account and credit card account details
- tax file number
- shareholding entity details
- any other personal information which we may require to provide the products and services to you

Methods of Collection

We collect personal information from you in a variety of ways, including:

- generally when you interact with us electronically or in person
- when you access our website
- when you subscribe for shares using our share application form and AML/CTF checklist
- through our agents and service providers
- from other forms which we may request to be completed by you

We will always undertake such collection by lawful and fair means usually from you directly, and not in an unreasonably intrusive way. If you do not wish to provide the information we request, we will tell you what impact this will have.

Purpose of information collected

We use your information for one or more of the following purposes:

- providing our services to you
- providing you with information or advertising about our services
- providing you an online experience that is tailored to your individual needs and preferences
- for event registration, invitations and post-event marketing
- processing queries and applications you have made
- providing you with information about companies whose business or opportunity you have indicated, may be of interest to you
- providing you with information about other services that we offer which may be of interest to you
- providing you with information about other services that our affiliates offer, that may be of interest to you
- providing you with promotional information about the ASSOB group of companies
- facilitating our internal business operations, including the fulfillment of any legal requirements
- analysing our services and customer needs with a view to developing new and/or improved services

Disclosure of your personal information

We will only disclose personal information about you for the purposes for which it was collected, as set out above. We also work with a number of other parties to deliver our services to you. In certain circumstances we may share personal information with them which relates to the main reason we collected the information.

Security of your personal information

We are committed to protecting your privacy and will take reasonable steps to ensure that the information we collect is protected from loss and misuse and from unauthorised access, modification and disclosure. However we are not liable for any unauthorised access to this information.

If we no longer require personal and sensitive information for any of the purposes for which it may legally be used or disclosed, we will take reasonable steps to destroy or permanently de-identify it.

Access to your personal information

If you ask us, we will usually give you access to the personal information we hold about you. There is generally no cost for accessing the personal information we hold about you, unless the request is complex or resource intensive. If there is a charge, it will be reasonable and we will let you know what it is going to be so that you can agree to it before we go ahead. Should you wish to access and update your personal information, please direct your request to our Privacy Officer at info@assob.com.au. You may be required to provide suitable identification to enable us to protect the security and privacy of your personal information.
